WHAT IS ACADEMIC ADVISING?

- It happens once every semester.
- You look at upcoming classes and pick which courses you want/need to take next semester
- Every school has its own system

WHAT IS THE PROTOCOL?

- 1. You review advising instructions and select courses
- 2. You email myself and the registrar your schedule proposal
- 3. We review and email you either to approve or to suggest changes
- 4. You register in student portal for the courses

WHY WOULD WE SUGGEST CHANGES?

Academic advising involves looking at the classes you need to take to graduate in your specific degree and track, then compares those to the classes you've already taken.

- Sometimes you can't take one class before you have taken another (pre-req)
- There are rules about how many classes to take and which classes to take (ex. must take at least 1 bible course every semester).




